Use Dropbox or Google Drive to send a link of your video (and a copy of music permissions, if applicable) to filmfestival@latinschool.org. **2)** Complete this application form and submit online with your **\$10 application fee**. Email the completed forms to filmfestival@latinschool.org. You may also hand deliver or snail mail the completed form along with a check made out to Latin School of Chicago to 59 W. North Blvd., Chicago, IL 60610. **3) All entries must be submitted by Monday, April 20 in order to qualify. 1. Complete this application form and [pay the \\$10 fee online](#), then simply email the completed forms to filmfestival@latinschool.org. Students who do not attend the Latin School of Chicago should upload a QuickTime version of the video to Google Drive or Dropbox (along with a copy of music permissions, if applicable), and email the link to filmfestival@latinschool.org. If films are submitted on a DVD, it will not be returned.
2. If copyrighted still or moving images OR copyrighted music or sound are used, the student submitting the film accepts full responsibility for obtaining permission to use the copyrighted material. [Learn more about copyrighted material](#).
3. Films must be at least 1 minute and no longer than 20 minutes. They may not contain vulgar language, graphic violence or sexual themes. We reserve the right to refuse any film.
4. By entering the festival, students agree to release their film for viewing by an audience of the general public in addition to viewings by a panel of judges. Films will be previewed by event organizers and judged for selection. Several films (15 –20) will become finalists to be screened by our esteemed panel of judges and the audience. The finalists will receive an email and their names will be posted on our website (chicagolandfilmfestival.org) by Monday, May 4, 2015. Finalist student filmmakers are expected to attend the festival on May 15, 2015 from 7:30-10 p.m. at Latin School of Chicago, 59 W. North Ave, Chicago. If you are unable to attend, please email filmfestival@latinschool.org with the name of the representative who will serve in your place.
5. Prizes will be awarded at the festival by a panel of impartial judges. All decisions are final.
